
Never assume that a new customer is automatically "yours" and will call you the next time they need service. People have busy lives and memories are short, so there's a good chance they won't even remember your name.

#### Residential Dehumidification: Whole-House vs. Portable

Excessive humidity in a home can cause various issues. It can make the air feel heavy and sticky, which in turn requires more heating or cooling to feel comfortable. Too much moisture in the air can also promote growth of mold, mildew and dust mites, and ruin furniture, clothing, electronics, and other household items. In addition to proper ventilation, particularly in kitchens and bathrooms, a good solution is a portable or whole-house dehumidifier. Because dehumidified air feels cooler, thermostats can be set to higher temperatures during cooling season, which helps to lower energy bills. A savings of 5-7% on utility bills can be expected for every two degrees a thermostat is raised.

Here are some common signs of excessive humidity:

- Musty or mildew odors
- Condensation stains on walls or ceilings
- Condensation on windows
- Cracking/flaking paint or peeling wallpaper
- Consistently damp areas
- Need to lower the thermostat or run A/C more frequently to feel comfortable

Choosing between a whole-house and a portable dehumidifier depends on individual needs. Benefits of whole-house units include humidity control throughout the home, less noise, and they're up to four times more energy efficient than portable units. They are more expensive on initial purchase, but quickly pay for themselves in energy savings. Portable dehumidifiers are less expensive to purchase, but they are loud, less efficient, require frequent emptying, and can only dehumidify a limited area. Portable units are a good option for dehumidifying damp basements, but for most applications, whole-house units are usually the better choice.
